



Lessee Insurance Requirements

Please forward this information along with a spec sheet of the unit being rented to your insurance agent or risk manager and have your policy endorsed as noted below to avoid any delays as a result of insufficient coverage.

Before renting any equipment from Utility Equipment Leasing Corporation or one of its dealers, you will be required to provide a certificate of insurance, which meets the following requirements. All coverages must be compliant with the AM Best Rating System, rated A VIII or better.

Commercial General Liability – Naming UELC as Additional Insured

- \$1,000,000 Each Occurrence
- \$2,000,000 General Aggregate
(\$1,000,000 applying to Products-Completed/Operations)

Commercial Automobile Liability – Naming UELC as Additional Insured and Loss Payee

- \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit
- Hired Physical Damage to the Actual Cash Value of unit – i.e. cost to repair or replace unit
(*amount must be listed as “per unit” on the certificate*)
- \$1,000 max. deductible for Comprehensive & Collision (Lessee is responsible for deductible amount)

Excess/Umbrella Liability

- \$1,000,000 **MINIMUM** Each Occurrence

Crane of Mobile Equipment Rentals – Contractors Equipment Floater with Leased/Rented Sublimit Equal to the Actual Cash Value of the Unit. No exclusion for Jib or Boom Overload (*must be listed on certificate*).

Occasionally it is necessary to exchange the original rental unit for a different unit, **OR** you may desire to rent more than one piece of equipment at a time. Therefore, we recommend that the insurance certificate and Auto Liability coverage be written with the provision for “All Hired Equipment”.

Self-Insured Requirements

- Verification on Company Letterhead
- Include Levels of Retention
- Statement of Coverage for Rental Vehicles
- Statement of Indemnification of Utility Equipment Leasing Corporation while vehicle is in customer’s care, possession, and control
- Renewed Yearly
